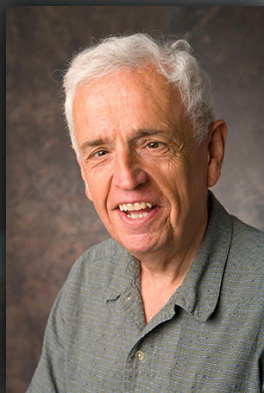

Father Larry Gillick, SJ



Father Larry Gillick, SJ is the Director of the Ignatian Spirituality Centre at Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska. He was born in Milwaukee and entered the Society of Jesus in 1960. He was ordained in 1972 after completing his Theology Studies at Regis College in Toronto, Ontario.

For the past 40 years he has ministered among the students and faculty of Creighton University, as well as giving guided and personally directed retreats in Canada and United States.

Sister Bernadette O'Reilly, NDS



Sister Bernadette entered the Sisters of Sion in 1973. She completed Masters in Divinity and taught theology in High School for several years. In 1979 she moved to Winnipeg in response to a call from the Sisters of Sion to create a new community, living in the inner city and working with the Indigenous community.

Sister Bernadette began teaching at the Junior High Program at Rossbrook House and later opened an alternative High School Program. She became Co-Director of Rossbrook House, a position she held for more than 20 years.

Alongside her work at Rossbrook House, Sister Bernadette has held many roles within the Sisters of Sion Community. She has been Provincial of Canada/USA, Novice Director, Provincial Treasurer and Formation Director in Central America.

For many years she has also done Spiritual Direction and retreats in the Ignatian Tradition.
